Mission Statement:

The Beauregard Agape Community Clinic exists to improve the physical, emotional and relationship (both with the creator and with others) health of working citizens of Beauregard and the areas of Vernon and Allen Parishes surrounding DeRidder, whose resources do not permit adequate access to health care in the private sector.

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Working for the Working Uninsured

Beauregard Agape Community Clinic is a not-for-profit corporation whose reason for existence is to help meet the health needs of citizens in the area who work, but whose resources do not permit adequate access to medical care in the private sector of the community. It is supported by citizens in the community who are sympathetic to the needs of their fellow citizens. It is a totally volunteer organization staffed by a large number of individuals giving their time, expertise and heart to achieve the mission of the organization.



Goals

- *To focus on significant health issues affecting the working uninsured population.
- *To assess health care needs versus available services for the low income, uninsured, working community.
- *To encourage early prevention and treatment of illnesses for low income, uninsured, working families in Beauregard Parish and surrounding communities.
- *To recruit and coordinate community resources and volunteers in an effort to ensure that health care services are available to those in need.
- *To increase awareness and prevention of disease through patient education and counseling.

Eligible Applicants

- *People and/or families working a minimum of 20 hours a week and earning less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.
- *People who are unemployed for six months or less and actively seeking employment.
- *Self supporting full time students 'working' toward their education: i.e.: college, technical school, barber or beauty school.

Ineligible Applicants

- *Persons enrolled in Medicaid, Medicare, LA Chip, or covered by ANY kind of health insurance plan (including dental, hospitalization, cancer) are **ineligible** for services.
